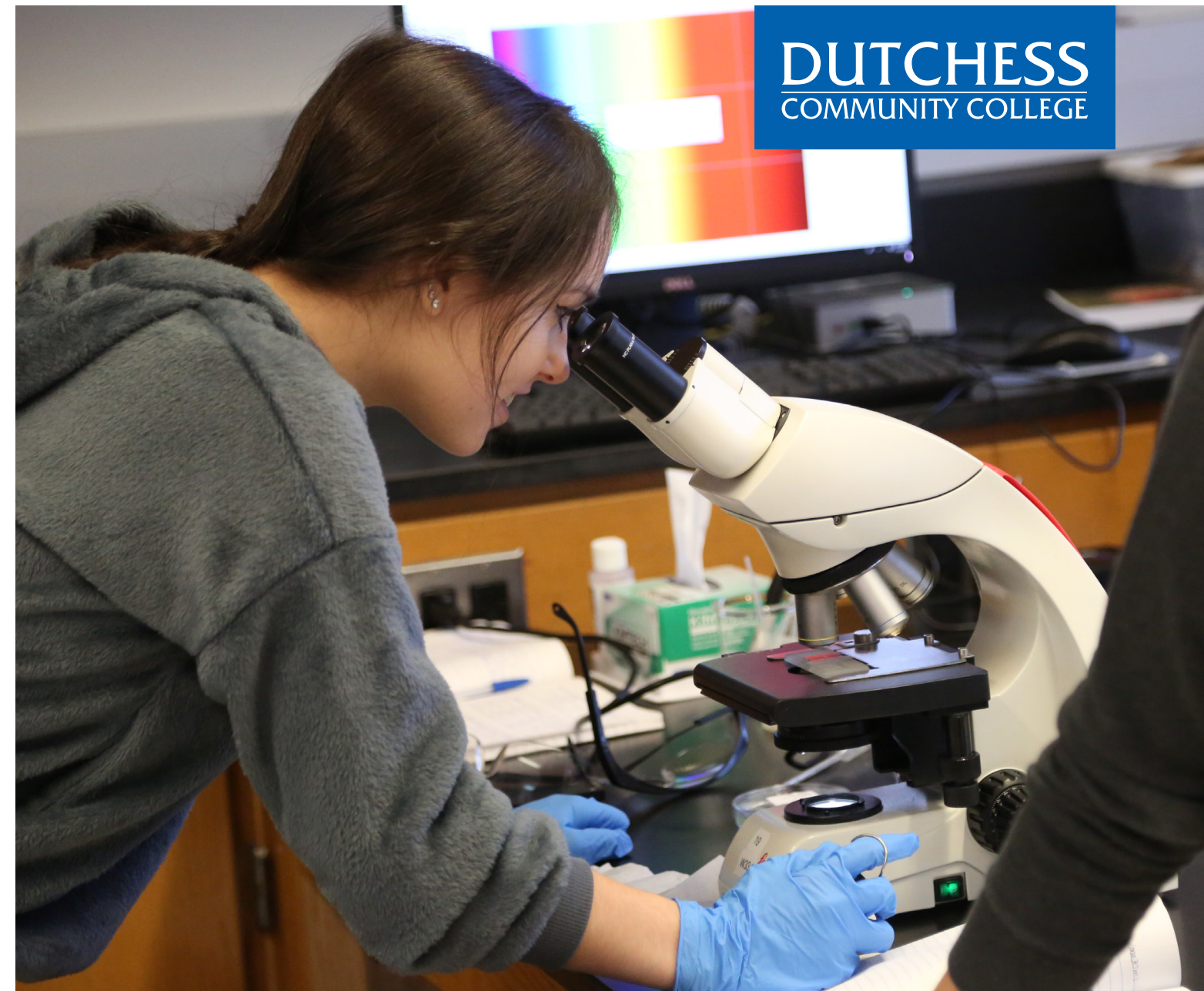

# Scholarships for Incoming Students

## Arlington American Legion Scholarship – \$500

This scholarship is for a student who will be attending DCC immediately following graduation from Arlington High School. The student must have a 2.0 GPA or higher to be eligible. Preference will be given to a dependent of a member of the American Legion Post 1302. The essay should discuss how the scholarship will make a difference in the applicant's life.

## Jordan E. Bell STEM Scholarship for Women – \$500

The Jordan E. Bell STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) Scholarship for Women was established by DCC English Instructor Jordan E. Bell to be awarded to a female student. The award will be paid over the fall semester and may be used for tuition and fees. Eligible students must have a high school GPA of 80 or higher, be entering into any STEM field major and write an essay that discusses what contribution the applicant hopes to make to the STEM field.

## Chevron-Texaco Beacon Scholarship – \$2,875

The scholarship will be awarded to two students graduating from Beacon High School who will attend DCC full-time the Fall and who have maintained a 2.0 GPA. All FASFA information must be completed prior to applying for the scholarship. The student must be approved by Dawn Smith in the Guidance Office at Beacon High School.

## Dutchess County Youth Board & Coordinating Council Scholarship – \$1,500

This scholarship will be awarded to a student who has either overcome difficult circumstances or hardships to be successful in school and/or life; or has demonstrated outstanding contributions through community service. This first-year scholarship will be paid over the student's first two semesters and may be used for tuition and fees. Eligible students must have a GPA of 2.8 or higher, be involved in community activities and be under 25 years old. The applicant must submit an essay on one of the following topics: describe how you have overcome some specific hardship or difficult obstacle to be successful in life and/or school or; describe your contributions to the community through volunteering.

## JDJ “Mulligan” Scholarship – \$750

This scholarship was established by Jerry and Denise M. Janiec, who both attended DCC as non-traditional students and graduated in 1995 and 1993, respectively. This scholarship will be awarded to an incoming or continuing non-traditional student who has decided to return to college to either further her/his career or to start a new one in any field of study offered by DCC. The essay should discuss why the applicant is returning to college.

## Junior League of Poughkeepsie Scholarship – \$750

This first-year scholarship will be awarded to an incoming, female student and will be paid over the student's first and second semesters, beginning in fall 2021, and may be used for tuition and fees. Eligible students must have a 2.5 or higher GPA, be female, demonstrate interest in community volunteerism and write an essay that discusses her community involvement and how her interests align with the Junior League's mission. In lieu of an essay, applicants may submit a brief biography and a list of their community activities.

## Key Bank Scholarship – \$1,000

This scholarship will be awarded to five incoming students. Each student must be a permanent resident of New York, have a high school GPA of 2.5 and a history of community involvement. The essay should discuss the applicant's community involvement.

## Kirchhoff Family Scholarship for Home-Schooled Students – \$3,600

This scholarship was established by the Kirchhoff Family to be awarded to a student who is home-schooled, resides in Dutchess County and will enter DCC on a full-time basis. This scholarship will be paid over the student's first two semesters at Dutchess Community College and may be used for tuition and fees. Eligible students must have an SAT score of at least 1000, an ACT score of 22 or a GPA of at least 3.0. They also must place into college-level courses on the placement exam and be involved in community activities. The essay should discuss the applicant's community involvement and how the scholarship will make a difference in their life.

## Charles E. and Mabel E. Conklin Scholarship for Academic Excellence - Full Tuition

This scholarship provides up to two years of full tuition for any Dutchess County high school student who graduates in the top 10% of his or her class and enrolls at DCC for the following fall. ## General Requirements

To be eligible to apply for a scholarship, you must meet the below listed criteria:

### Dutchess County Graduate

You must graduate in June from a New York state-approved high school in Dutchess County, NY (or a high school designated by New York for Dutchess County residents) and be a Dutchess County resident.

### English and Math

You must be advised into college-level Math and English based on placement test results, review of high school transcript and/or SAT/ACT results.

### FAFSA

You must apply for federal and state financial aid using the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) every academic year by June 1 if eligible.

### Full-Time Student

You must attend Dutchess Community College as a full-time student in the fall semester and all subsequent semesters. Scholarships greater than \$500 will be paid out over two or more semesters.

### Essay

You must submit an essay, not to exceed 500 words, as outlined in each scholarship description.

### Letter of Recommendation

You must submit one professional letter of recommendation written by a high school teacher, guidance counselor, community member or another professional source such as an employer. Letters from friends or family members will not be considered.

### Thank-you note

You must write a thank-you note to the scholarship donor.

- 1 Complete the Dutchess Community College application online at [connect.sunydutchess.edu/apply](http://connect.sunydutchess.edu/apply).
- 2 Fill out the online scholarship application at [sunydutchess.academicworks.com](http://sunydutchess.academicworks.com) or complete this scholarship application and return it to the DCC Foundation.
- 3 Complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), available at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov), if eligible.
- 4 You must place into college level English and math. Students may be exempt from portions of the placement test based on high school and/or college transcripts, and SAT or ACT scores. Do not take the test until we review all transcripts.
- 5 Arrange for your high school to submit to DCC two official transcripts that note your cumulative grade point average and your class rank. One transcript should be submitted when you apply, the other when you graduate.
