DUTCHESS COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND THE DUTCHESS COUNTY CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION (CSEA) ARE PLEASED TO PROVIDE A TUITION WAIVER PROGRAM.

Pursuant to an agreement between the County of Dutchess and CSEA (Dutchess County Unit, DC Local 814) full-time and part-time civil service employees, including employees of the County of Dutchess and Dutchess Community College exclusively appointed to permanent positions, are eligible to receive a tuition waiver when enrolling for credit courses at Dutchess Community College.*

This innovative agreement can mean a nearly free college education for any permanent civil service employee of Dutchess County.

Dutchess Community College has 62 degree and certificate programs to choose from, and a caring faculty and staff who are dedicated to student success.

Please note: This application for tuition waiver will be submitted to the Dutchess County Department of Human Resources for confirmation of employee's eligibility.

*Employees of New York state and local municipalities and school districts are not included in the tuition waiver program, but they should call the College to find out if they are eligible for other sources of funding to attend DCC.

Frequently Asked Questions:

What will I have to pay for if I enroll at Dutchess Community College?

You pay no tuition, but you are responsible for the cost of your books, College fees and any other applicable course fees.

How do I decide what to study?

You must indicate which degree or certificate program you are interested in at the time of enrollment. However, this can be changed at any time. A list of the College's degree and certificate programs can be found on the reverse side of the application, and you can call for a catalog, or go to our website at sunydutchess.edu to find out about academic programs.

Will I be able to take a course in the evening, if I want?

The College offers courses during the day, in the evening, and on Saturdays to make sure that the excellence of a Dutchess education is available to the most people possible.

Courses also are offered at Dutchess South,

Wappingers Falls. Online courses are offered for experienced learners.

What if I need financial aid?

Once you've applied, you can call the DCC Office of Financial Aid at (845) 431-8030 to find out about additional funding sources.

Once I've decided what to study, how do I register for classes?

You can register by coming to the Registrar's Office, Orcutt Student Services Center, Room 202 Monday - Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

You will receive written confirmation of your registration. You must pay a \$50 deposit which will be applied to fees while waiting for County approval of the tuition waiver.
