STRINGS

INSTRUMENTS AND MATERIALS:

String instrument sizes fit the student, who should be measured by the teacher or the strings retailer. For violin or cello rentals, contact Stamell Strings at (845) 337-3030, Amadeus Strings at (845) 486-7617, or Joseph Regh Violins at (845) 297-2521.

Rental allows you to change violin size if the student is a growing child, and rental fees may often be applied to purchase when ready. Some dealers allow trade-ins on purchased instruments as well. Purchase of some low-cost music textbooks may be needed, depending on the instructor and the class.
