

English Placement Levels

To streamline placement, we've created 3 placement levels in English, similar to math. Additionally, Transfer students still may be exempt based on college-level work, as usual. The table below applies to all incoming students, including early-admit students.

*See testing recommendations for students who completed ENL coursework in high school

Scores are valid for 5 years, after which point students are required to test.

Students who do not fall into these levels are required to test using either the Writeplacer or the Versant/PEP test, as appropriate:

- GED score from another state
- High school or TASC records more than 5 years old
- ENL students without the required regents score = ESL placement test (PEP or Versant, as available)
- International high school credentials
