



ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

**State University College of Technology at Delhi
(SUNY Delhi)**

and

**Dutchess Community College
Effective Date Fall 2018**

SUNY Delhi agrees to articulate with Dutchess Community College by providing opportunities for appropriately qualified students to complete SUNY Delhi's online Bachelor of Science in Nursing program. Students selected for matriculation in this program, upon satisfactory completion of the following, can continue their studies at the SUNY Delhi.

While admission to the SUNY Delhi is competitive, students satisfying the following will be accepted with full junior status:

1. Graduation from an Associate Degree in Nursing program
2. Current RN license
3. Nursing coursework grades must be a C+ or better
4. Liberal arts and science courses must be a C or better. Required courses include Anatomy and Physiology I & II, Microbiology, English, and Psychology
5. Cumulative GPA of 2.8 or above for prerequisite credits

*We recommend student be pre-advised for Statistics – if transferring in Statistics students are waived from ALHT 202.

Courses required for BSN at Delhi

The following criteria must be met:

1. Graduation from an Associate Degree in Nursing program
 2. Current RN license
 3. Nursing coursework grades must be a C+ or better
 4. Liberal arts and science courses must be a C or better. Required courses include Anatomy and Physiology I & II, Microbiology, English, and Psychology
 5. Cumulative GPA of 2.8 or above for prerequisite credits
- *Although not required, it's recommended student be pre-advised for Statistics – if transferring in Statistics students are waived from ALHT 202.
