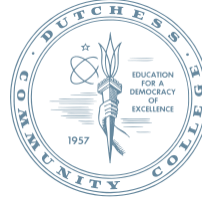

Minimum requirements:

- 3.0 GPA and no grades below a C
- Nomination/recommendation by a faculty member or an academic coach
- Completion of at least one full-time semester at DCC
- Good academic standing and no conduct issues
- Full-time status with at least 12 credits at DCC (or 9 credits at DCC and 3 credits (1 unit) at Vassar, if the Vassar class is degree-applicable, as approved by DCC Registrar**)

Application deadline:

November 12, 2021

Required materials:

- Application
- Nomination by faculty or advisor/letter of recommendation
- In 500 words or less, tell us about your interest in the program and how it will benefit you
- Unofficial DCC transcript (can be downloaded from myDCC)

If selected to participate, you will:

- Complete DCC cross-registration form and Vassar College Medical History and Immunization Form. Students MUST have a physical and PPD test done within the last year.
- Meet with the Advisor for Special Students at Vassar College to discuss the appropriate coursework and obtain permission from the relevant faculty member to enroll in the class.
- Registration for Vassar class will take place in late January/early February
- In order to receive transfer credit, ensure that the course is applicable to the DCC degree as per DCC Registrar's approval.
- Vassar class will be taught remotely.
- Students receiving GI Bill benefits should consult with Stewart Dawes, Veterans Resource Coordinator.

In order to receive transfer credit, the course taken at Vassar must be applicable and fulfill a missing requirement towards the student's current degree or certificate program at Dutchess. A grade of C or better must be earned. The grade will appear on the Vassar transcript; DCC transcript will reflect a "T".

The student would be able to drop the course through the drop deadline, which is about halfway through the semester. Up until the 9th week of classes, the student can request to be withdrawn with a WD notation on the transcript. After the 9th week, only Advisor for Special Students can withdraw the student under mitigating circumstances ("health or serious emergency").

*If the program is remote, health forms and PPD test will not be required. If classes are in-person, students will need to show proof of immunization, physical exam and PPD test.

**We recommend that you register for full-time course load at DCC while your application is being reviewed.

Vassar College limits the number of students to five (5) per semester. Priority may be given to students who are closer to graduation. Students who did not get selected may re-apply for next semester.
